The fee structure for the 2022-2023 CAAT programs is listed above. The total fee is divided into equal monthly increments regardless of the number of days in a particular month. In order to be up to date with the payment schedule new participants starting midyear are required to make two payments. **It is important that your payment is received on time so the teachers and staff can be paid by the agency.**

PayPal payments and money orders are the only acceptable forms of payment. Personal checks will be mailed back to you. **If you are submitting a money order, please write your child(ren)'s name and the school on the memo line or the lower right hand corner of the money order.** Keep all money order receipts as record of payment. Late payments or non-payment will exclude the child from monthly registration.

Experienced NYC Department of Education licensed teachers and paraprofessionals from each host school will supervise CAAT activities. The program will be conducted in a wholesome, safe and fun filled environment. Program activities will include homework help, arts and crafts, and age appropriate recreational sports games.

All students must obey the rules of conduct as set forth by the teacher in charge. Unruly behavior will be noted and parents will be asked to remove the child from the program, according to the rules explained in the participant handbook. Any child who has been removed in the past will need to be interviewed by the CAAT Supervisor before attending again. The CAAT program's staff to student ratio abides by Department of Health and Hygiene regulations; one on one programming is not offered by this program. If the participant requires a full-time para the parent(s) is responsible for providing one.

**CAAT programs end promptly at 6:00pm** so please make sure that the designated pick up person is aware, as there are no provisions for childcare after the 6:00pm closing. An emergency contact person must be listed on your application.





# NYC Department of Education School Year Calendar

This is the 2022–23 school year calendar for all 3K–12 NYCDOE public schools. If your child attends a private, parochial, charter school, NYCEEC Early Childhood Community-Based Organization or Family Childcare Program, please contact your child’s school for information about their calendar. Please note the following:

- November 8, Election Day, is a non-attendance day for students. No in-person or remote instruction will be provided.
- On “Snow days” or days when school buildings are closed due to an emergency, all students and families should plan on participating in remote learning.
- Individual schools’ Parent-Teacher Conference dates might be different from the dates below. Your child’s teacher will work with you to schedule your conference.
- On this schedule, elementary schools are defined as programs that serve kindergarten (K) through grade 8, including schools with 3K and Pre-K, as well as those that end in grade 5. Middle schools are defined as programs that serve grades 6–8, and high schools are defined as programs that serve grades 9–12.
